Some of the fastest tarmac stages in Europe take place in and around the open, flowing countryside

surrounding the old service area at Bostalsee . Some sections on the Bosenberg, St. Petersburg, and St. Wendler Land stages are absolutely flat-out and require total commitment from the Drivers, particularly given the often changeable weather conditions...

Baumholder...

This infamous stage held on military ground around the USAF base has seen several huge accidents over the years where drivers have crashed heavily after hitting concrete 'Hinkelsteins' (tank-traps!). For the spectator there is the chance to see the cars several times from one viewing position as the cars struggle for grip on the mixture of concrete, asphalt & gravel surfaces. It's now almost traditional for the odd thunderstorm to liven up the proceedings during Saturday afternoon as well!
